



COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Josh was raised in Silver Spring where he was exposed to community service from a very young age. His parents, Marc & Debbie Katz, were involved with every organization that their schedules would allow.

He got his business education at the school of hard knocks under the mentorship of Sammy Franco. Between Marc and Sammy he learned early on that businesses can be used to serve a higher purpose than simply conducting business.



In 2012 Josh acquired Ben Yehuda Pizza and was inspired by the Torah School to start giving back to the community through events such as Tuition Tuesday. 




